

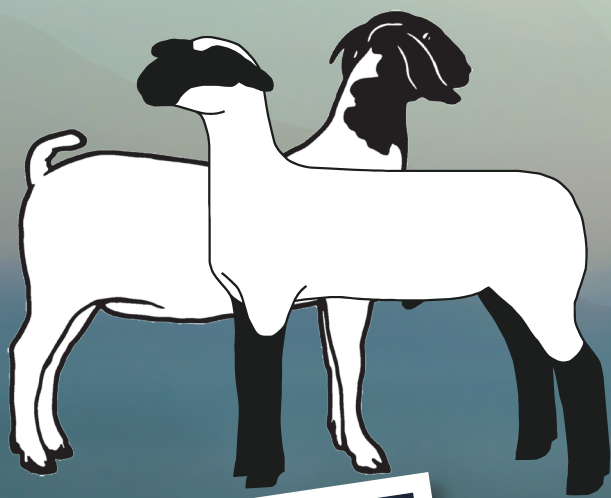
MOUNTAIN STATE

The mission of the Mountain State Show Series is to promote an environment that will allow junior market lamb and goat exhibitors to be actively involved in an ethical, practical and educational series of shows that culminates with a season ending rewards program based on performance while making the entire experience enjoyable for the participating exhibitors and their families.

*For the 2016 season we are only doing a showmanship series

Eligibility: Participants of the Mountain State Show Series do not have to be residents of West Virginia (Keep in mind that the State Fair of West Virginia does not allow out of state participants).

By competing in 3 of 5 showmanship events that make up the circuit, participants will automatically be eligible for year end awards. No registration or dues will be collected the first year. Participants will receive a t-shirt for competing in 3 of 5 shows. Additional prizes will be awarded to youth that participate in 5 of 5 shows.

*Due to age restrictions Pee Wee exhibitors will not be able to compete at the State Fair of West Virginia. Pee Wee exhibitors will receive a t-shirt for competing in 2 shows and eligible for additional awards for competing in 4 of 4 shows.

Age Divisions:

1. Pee Wee	8 and under
2. Junior	9 to 13
3. Intermediate	14 to 16
4. Senior	17 to 21

(Show open to any youth under 21 years old as of Jan. 1, 2016.)

Scoring System

1st	15 points
2nd	13 points
3rd	11 points
4th	9 points
5th	7 points
Made Finals	6 points (when classes within a division are split creating a final drive within a division)
All others	5 points

- An Individual's top 3 scores will count toward year-end Awards
- Ties will be broken in the following order:
 1. Head to head competition will be considered
 2. All dropped scores will be added.
 3. Additional prizes will be given if the tie remains.

Award ceremony will be held at the State Fair of West Virginia following the lamb and goat shows.
