Categories

1. Scenic - (no people) Sheep and/or Goat pictures.
2. Action - Sheep and/or Goat. (Ex: showing, lambing, shearing, etc)
3. Whimsical - (funny) sheep and/or goats with people or other animals, etc.

Agreement

Entries will be handled with reasonable care, but the WV Purebred Sheep Breeders involved with or aiding in the exhibit will not be responsible for loss or damage from any cause whatsoever.



Entry

Entries can be delivered between 3-6 pm on Friday and 8-9:30 am on Saturday. Or make arrangement to get your entries to a WV Purebred Sheep Breeders Member.

Exhibits

Exhibits will be open to the public on June 5, 2010 from 11:30 am to 1:30 pm at the Tri-County Fairgrounds.

Entry Pick Up

Work must be picked up between 1:30 - 2:30 pm on Saturday, June 5, 2010. We cannot mail back the entries that are not picked up. Pictures that are not picked up will become the property of the WV Purebred Sheep Breeders, unless other arrangements are made.

Entry Fee

\$1.00 Per entry, with maximum of 5 entries per person. Make checks payable to WV Purebred Sheep Breeders.

Judging

Judging of the photographs will take place on Saturday June 5, 2010 at 10:30 am.

Awards

Best of Show will receive cash and a ribbon. First, Second, and Third in all categories will receive a ribbon. All others will receive a participation ribbon.

Requirements

1. All work must be original and photographic in nature. Photocopies are not acceptable.
2. All work must have the following information on the back: name, address, age, phone number, category and title. Any entries showing name or other information on the front of work will not be eligible.
3. Each exhibitor must complete an entry form (on reverse side) and submit with work. Be sure to enclose proper fees.
4. Prints must be matted. Prints are not to be framed.
5. Photographer's name must not be on the front of the picture or mat.  
Minimum size including mat is 4x6  
Maximum size including mat is 16x20
6. Work not meeting the above requirements will not be accepted - no exceptions.
7. Each work will be judged only in the category for which it is submitted. If no category is designated by entrant, the exhibit committee will assign one.
